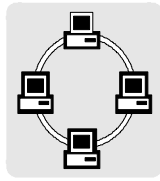


What is Doc-a-Ware

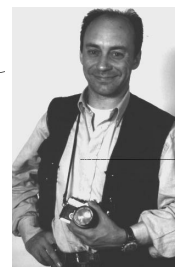

Alessandro Consonni: Art Photographer and director of the Italian magazine "Arti figurate". Interest and studies in geographic and environmental questions.



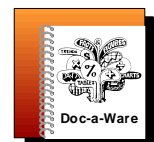

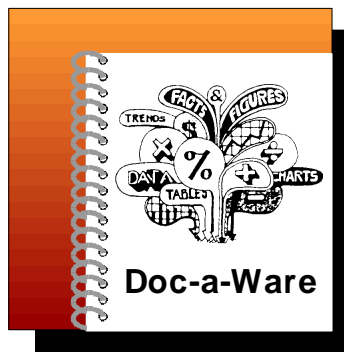
Franco Beretta: Mastery in art graphics and image production. Director of the Art Graphics Office of technical magazines.
